RE: Invitation to Organize an Enrichment Cluster

As you may know, the Enrichment Team at Windham Center School is organizing a series of enrichment clusters for all students in the school. Enrichment clusters are organized as multiaged groups of students who share a common interest with the person organizing the cluster. We will begin with a pilot series scheduled to run during the afternoons of November 11, November 18, December 2, and December 9. We hope you will be interested in submitting an idea based upon a personal interest or talent.

The main rationale for participation in a cluster is that students and presenters want to be there. Based on an interest, students will select one cluster that they will attend beginning with the four-session pilot series. After the pilot, a longer series of enrichment clusters will be organized to begin in January.

Enrichment clusters are organized around major disciplines, interdisciplinary themes, or cross-disciplinary topics (e.g., a theatrical production group that includes actors, writers, technical specialists, costume designers, etc.). Enrichment clusters will be connected in various ways to the regular curriculum already offered. You don't have to be the "expert" in the topic you select. You and your students can explore a topic together.

Descriptions of sample enrichment clusters are listed following this letter to help give you some ideas for different types of clusters that can be organized. Your own description may be very different from the samples. Feel free to "team up" with a friend. If you would like to assist with a cluster, that is another option.
